Pets Alive fixes 8,492 cats & dogs from 52 counties in 2010

1,123 spay/neuters were for City of Bloomington shelter
Now 43,000 pets fixed since Bloomington clinic's opening in 2005

Bloomington IN – The Pets Alive Nonprofit Spay/Neuter Clinic performed 8,492 spay/neuter surgeries on cats and dogs in 2010. The clinic offers high-quality surgeries at fees subsidized by donor contributions so that people who could not otherwise afford it are able to fix their pets.

December 2010 surgeries brought the cumulative total of animals fixed since the clinic's opening in 2005 to 43,038.

Even with this kind of volume, Pets Alive Executive Director James McNamara said the skilled staff approach clinic operations one pet at a time. "We have amazing people who provide individual care even with these patient loads. They're excellent at what they do and mission-driven -- they're all about saving lives."

Cats and dogs from 52 different Indiana counties were fixed at the clinic last year.

1,807 pets were fixed for members of the general public who scheduled appointments directly with the clinic. Another 1,123 spay/neuters were performed for the City of Bloomington Animal Shelter as part of their program to fix all animals prior to adoption.

McNamara said he was particularly gratified by Pets Alive's partnership with the City of Bloomington shelter and their spay/neuter-before-adoption program. "It's the model and not common in Indiana. It's cost-efficient for the shelter and showing results."



Pets Alive worked with transport partners in 20 counties to bring cats and dogs to the Bloomington surgery clinic.



The Pets Alive transport operation, not including the Bloomington shelter, accounted for 67% of the animals fixed. The clinic worked with 23 partners in 20 Indiana counties to bring 5,562 cats and dogs to the clinic in Bloomington for spay/neuter surgery in 2010.

Overall the clinic's totals last year broke down into 55% cats and 45% dogs. Of the pets fixed 56% were female and 44% male.
